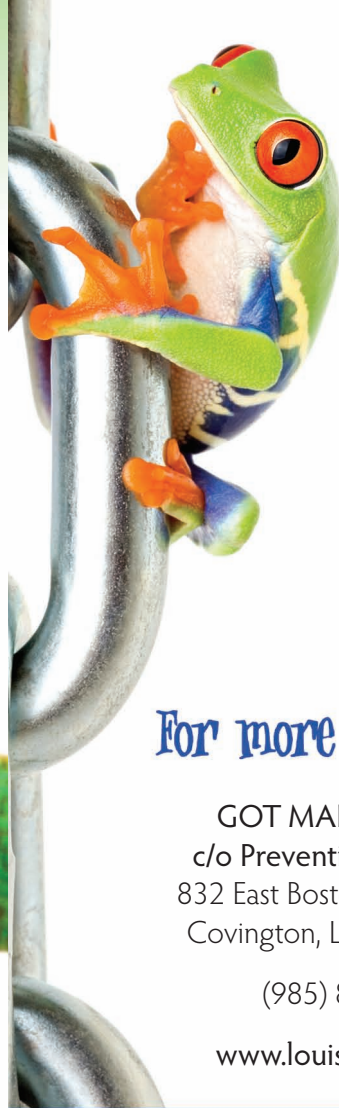
Louisiana needs 125 students who are ready to make big changes in their communities.

Youth participants pay administrative fee of \$50 each.



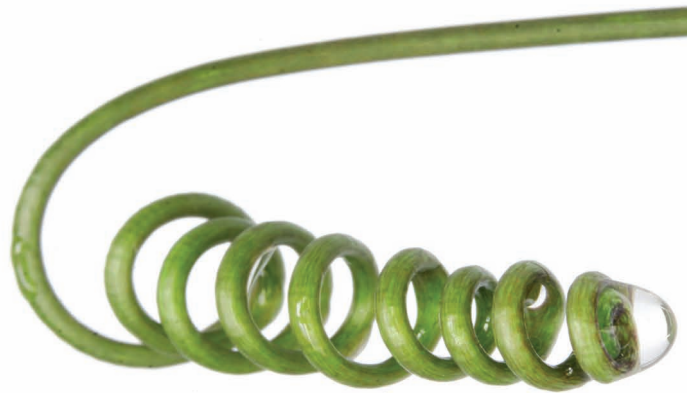
got details...

GOT is designed for students who are leaders in their schools and communities. Students must be drug-free and have a firm belief that alcohol should not be consumed by anyone under 21 years old. Students should be eager to do everything they can to stop drug use, including underage drinking.

Students must be a part of a school or community team to attend GOT. Teams consist of 6-12 youth with an approved adult participant.

Youth must be entering grades 9, 10, 11 or 12 in the 2008-09 school year.

An adult participant is someone who has been approved by GOT management to lead a team.
